At Lichfield the 19th Day of November 1834 Before the Reverend **George Buckridge** Surrogate VG.

On which day appeared personally **Frances Leedham** and suggested that **William Leedham** late of Coton in the Elms in the parish of Lullington in the County of Derby and diocese of Lichfield and Coventry Butcher deceased died upwards of fourteen days ago Intestate and that therefore she is the Widow Redict of the said deceased and the person entitled to Letters of Administration of his Goods and Personal Estate. Wherefore , she prayed the same to be granted to her which the Surrogate upon her taking the usual oath and giving good security decreed accordingly I

personal Estate of the said deceased
at the time of his death did not
amount in value to the sum
of one hundred pounds
and the Administration was
decreed to pass the seal
