



Personal History of Arthur WHITE

as prepared by himself

1. Born at Leicester, England 25th August 1888.
2. Left England for New Zealand with mother & sister from Tilbury dock, London per R.M.S. Remuera (Capt; Greenstreet. N.Z. Shipping Coy) 19-12-1912
arriving Wellington N.Z. 3-2-1913.
3. Left N.Z. (As passenger escorting mother home) per N.Z. Shipping Coy boat "Rimutaka" from Wellington April 1916. Joining the New Zealand Expeditionary Force at Hornchurch; Essex England on 28th June 1916. Served on active service 3 years 66 days.
4. Married Ethel Baxter at Spondon, county of Derbyshire, England whilst member of Expeditionary Force on 24th February 1919.
5. Left England on Troopship (with wife) R.M.S. Athenic July 15th 1919 from Plymouth, arriving in Wellington, N.Z. 1-9-1919.
6. Joined N.Z. Police Force at Auckland 19th December 1919, doing duty at Auckland, New Market, Thames, Papakura, Whitianga and Mt Roskill.
7. Ceased to be a contributor to P.S. Superannuation fund as from 11-9-48.
8. Left the N.Z. Police Force (Resigned) 16-1-49 not since employed, but engaged on own account on carpentry work (additions to 2 roomed cottage Cockle Bay Rd Howick, where residing) work completed except for outside painting.
